APR. 5: LENTEN MEDITATION—On Saturday, Apr. 5, St. Lawrence Church will host the Chamber Singers of Messiah University with orchestra for a Lenten meditation. Buxtehude's *Membra Jesu Nostri* comprises of seven cantatas, each of which addresses a part of Jesus' crucified body: feet, knees, hands, side, breast, heart, and face. In each cantata, its main text is drawn from Biblical passages and the medieval hymn Salve mundi salutare, formerly ascribed to St. Bernard of Clairvaux but now thought to be by Cistercian monk Arnulf of Leuven. Notes on Today's Music

Processional hymn: Thy Grace, O Holy Ghost, Impart, 885 Hymn prior to Confirmation: Veni Creator Spiritus, 956 Recessional hymn: Crux Fidelis, 840; Credo VI, 788

Confirmation Antiphon: Confirma Hoc, John Mason Kyriale: Mass for Four Voices, William Byrd (c. 1543–1623) Offertory Antiphon: Meditabor in, G.P. Palestrina (c. 1525–1594) Motet after Offertory: Sicut Cervus, G.P. Palestrina

Communion Hymn: Audi Benigne Conditor, Orlandus Lassus

The hymn, Audi Benigne Conditor, is the Vespers Hymn during Lent and its Latin text is attributed to Pope St. Gregory the Great (540-604). Orlandus Lassus set the same text for five voices and divided the motet into two parts.

Orlandus Lassus (c.1532–1594) is known for the mature polyphonic style in the Franco-Flemish school. He wrote over 2,000 works in Latin, French, Italian, and German both sacred and secular.

ATTENTION YOUNG LADIES AGES 14-17—The Mater Dei Praesidium of the Legion of Mary hopes to form a junior praesidium here at St. Lawrence and would like to invite you to prayerfully consider joining! Sixteen- and seventeen-year-olds can be officers.

The Legion follows the method of St. Louis Marie de Montfort's True Devotion to Mary, as established by its founder Frank Duff in Ireland on September 7, 1921, and which has spread throughout the entire world. The apostolic work of the junior praesidium is varied and carried out in a variety of settings—some at the parish, others outside under the adult supervision of members of the Legion of Mary, and some in your home within your family. All of the work is of important value to the universal Church and to your parish and takes an additional commitment of one to one and a half hours per week.

FROM YOUR PARISH LIBRARIAN—The library has a new kiosk for checking books in and out, located by the librarian's desk. The procedure remains the same - The screen should show the Check in/out page. If you want to check out a book, touch the "Checkout" box. Take your library card and put it under the front of the screen, where there is a scanner. Make sure the barcode is facing upwards! The screen will show you as signed in. Scan the book barcode in the same way you scanned your card. The screen will now show your name and the book title. Touch the "I'm Done" box. Next, you can choose to have an email receipt sent to you. To check books back in, touch "Check in" and scan the book or books and then touch "I'm Done." If the screen does not show the Check in/out page, touch the home button.

If a login is asked for, touch "sign in with Google" and then choose "Library Kiosk," then "Continue." You are now automatically logged in to the correct page. Please email library@stlawrence.cc with any problems.
