Notes on Today's Music

Processional Hymn: O Glorious Maid Exalted Far, 911 Recessional Hymn: Daily, Daily, Sing of Mary, 912

Kyriale: Mass XI, 740; Credo II, 772

Offertory Antiphon: Exaltabo Te, Rev. Giovanni Croce

Marian Hymn: Omni Die, Dic Mariae, Chant

The Offertory Antiphon this week is sung chorally set by **Rev. Giovanni Croce.** The text is from Psalm 29:2-3: *I will magnify thee, O Lord, for thou hast set me up: and not made my foes to triumph over me.O Lord my God, I cried unto thee: and thou hast healed me.* Croce's sets each line of text in short sections with pairs or trios of voices that are followed soon by any remaining voices. He also makes use of the harmonic minor scale which creates a more brighter mood as the melodies rise and darker as they descend.

Rev. Giovanni Croce (c. 1558–1609) was an Italian priest and composer of the late Renaissance from Venice and contemporary of Monteverdi and Andrea Gabrieli. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1585. He was appointed to the prestigious position of *maestro di cappella* at the famous St. Mark's cathedral from 1603 until his death.

FREE SAT. & SUN. GARAGE PARKING—Our South Street Garage parking vouchers are valid both on Saturdays and Sundays. We now are offering self-service for obtaining vouchers. A sign-out sheet and vouchers are available at the back of the church and also on the table outside the parish office door. The South Street garage is available on Saturdays 7:30am - 8pm and on Sundays 7am - 2pm.

PARKING GARAGE REFUNDS—If you had a problem with the South Street Garage accepting your parking voucher last weekend, you can make a claim to get reimbursed at www. myparkingrefund.com/refund_form.php. This refund comes directly from the garage; the church is not charged. Even if you do not have your receipt if you provide the last four digits of your credit card and the date on which you parked a refund should be provided. The garage says you should hear back from them within seven business days of completeing the form. Park Harrisburg has acknowledged they experienced "hiccups" with the system accepting vouchers last Saturday. They understand that the left gate is more reliable than the right to take the vouchers but are working to get them both to accept the vouchers. If you have any problems, please request the refund at the above link, and please also notify the office so we can stay on top of the issue.
