ANNOUNCEMENTS

FROM YOUR PASTOR: CAMPAIGN STUDY—As you may know, the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter (FSSP) purchased the Parish Center (112 State Street) in 2022 and offered our parish five years free use of the building while we make determine the benefit the building would have to our parish and the means of the parish to purchase it.

In light of the June 30, 2027, deadline to decide to complete the purchase of the building, now is the time to seek critical feedback from each parishioner. At my request, the parish's finance council and planning committee have developed a plan to ensure that all our buildings continue to serve the mission entrusted to us.

We are studying the possibility of a capital campaign in order to buy the Parish Center by June 30, 2027. At the same time, we are considering several other projects as part of the possible campaign as well:

- Restore the church's rose window, and maintain and improve the schoolhouse.
- Expand the living space for our priests and visitors.
- Eliminate our parish debt, allowing us to direct more funding to mission and ministry.
- Start a classical elementary school.

We want to hear from you before we make any decisions. Starting tomorrow, we will begin a comprehensive survey of our entire parish community. We want to know which projects you believe are the most important for the future of St. Lawrence. The survey, which is part of a process called a planning study, also will gauge support the possible capital fundraising campaign.

In the coming weeks, we will share more details about the study, the projects, and about the possibility of a major fundraising effort to pay for some of the projects. Each parish family will be asked to share their input. Your participation in the survey is essential for the success of this planning process.—Fr. James M. Smith, FSSP

Notes on Today's Music

Processional hymn: Most Ancient of All Mysteries, 884 Recessional hymn: Lift Up Your Heads, Ye Mighty Gates, 931

Kyriale: Mass XI, 740; Credo IV, 780

Marian Antiphon: Salve Regina, Rev. Francesco Soriano

(c.1548-1621)

Communion Antiphon: Panis Quem Ego, Heinrich Isaac

The communion antiphon is set by **Heinrich Isaac** with the text taken from John 6:52: *The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.* Isaac composes pieces of the melody in both the Tenor and Soprano voices in a quasi-canon in the same way as many of his communion settings. *Panis Quem Ego* has one of the clearest quotations of the source melody in the Soprano voice with very little ornamentation.

Heinrich Isaac (c.1450–1517) was a Renaissance composer from the South Netherlandish region. His output was rivaled only by Orlandus Lassus in number and variety of composition. Most notable of his collections is *Choralis Constantinus* which contains nearly 400 Gregorian chant based motets of propers for the Mass.
