Dear Parishioners:

Thank you, on behalf of our beautiful parish, for your overwhelmingly generous response to our *Generation to Generations* Capital Campaign.

With the commitments made by 255 families or individuals, we have exceeded our highest pledge goal of \$2.1 million. As of yesterday, you have been so generous as to pledge a total of \$2,178,459. Of this amount, you have already given \$675,887. This is much faster than we expected and reflects so well upon your generosity, your love of your parish, and your commitment to the traditional liturgy of the Church.

The Steier Group, the company we hired to guide us through our campaign, estimates that we will receive 95 percent of all pledges because, due to unforeseen circumstances, some people will have to update their pledges. Because of this, we are still accepting additional pledges.

Your fulfilled pledges will help us to purchase the Parish Center from the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter (FSSP), eliminate our parish debt, restore the rose window of the church and the facilities of the schoolhouse, and expand the rectory space.

Just this week, we made our first payment from funds received from the Capital Campaign: we made an advanced payment of \$100,000 on our church mortgage. Of the \$1.5 million loan that we took out in 2022, we now owe less than \$750,000.

Once enough pledges have come in, we will take the next step in purchasing the Parish Center from the FSSP. Our deadline to do that is June 30 of next year, so we believe we are in a very good position to achieve that goal. At the same time, we will be looking for opportunities to begin work on the social hall and the other projects.

Thank you again for your investment in the future of St. Lawrence. Your generosity is greatly appreciated and very helpful for the continued growth of our community.
